Happy New Year from the LME Staff! Enrollment is still staying steady around 385 with a few new enrollments coming. A couple Staffing updates; A new 2 day/week posting has been posted to relieve Ms Locke, as well as Mrs. Stasiewski has resigned from her position at LME, new posting will be coming soon. Mon, Jan 12 was our first assembly of 2026, the students were split into 2 groups for the assembly, K-2 and 3-5. The theme of this assembly was Goal Setting. Thurs, Jan 15 at 8:45am, the French Immersion teachers from CMS are coming to chat with the Grade 5 Students. Grade 5 Students are also going to be taking part in a survey called the MDI (Middle Development Instrument) to check current Social and Emotional Development. Grade 4 Students will also have a Ministry distributed survey. Fri, Jan 23 is an Assessment and Evaluation Day and schools will be Closed. Mr Letson has started Floor Hockey . Practices currently take place during Lunch and Games after School. Ms. Jaworska has started Triple Ball, which is similar to Volleyball but easier for the Elementary Students.
