REPORTS:

A: Mr Bateman

Staffing 2025-26 – There are no new updates.

Halloween Parade and Remembrance Day Assembly both went extremely well. Kids really enjoyed the costume parade, as well as participating in the Remembrance Day Assembly. Was a great turn out from parents at the assembly.

December – December 5th is Deck the Halls Day, where students will decorate their classroom doors for Christmas. Our LME Food Drive will be beginning on December 8th and running until December 18th – Donations will go to the Salvation Army. December 10th is Wear your Christmas Sweater/Shirt as well as the Pancake Breakfast. Christmas Concerts will be preformed on December 16th and 17th at 1:00pm, with a Dress Rehearsal on December 16th at 9:00am – The gym will be closed from December 15th-18th for the Christmas Concerts. Report Cards will be sent home on December 18th. The final Spirit Day of 2025 will be Pajama Day on December 19th which is the last day of school, and the school will reopen on January 5th.

Lost and Found – The Lost and Founds are both growing, and parents should be coming in and taking a look if they notice that children are missing items. Uncollected items are donated at the end of each term.

B: PAC Chair – Jasmine

Coupon Book Sales, we made \$650 in profit. There are 2 coupon books left in the PAC Office if anyone is interested. Neufields Sales, we made \$811 in profit. Purdy's ends on November 30th, so far sales are looking good. We are also still looking for Volunteers to help sort orders when they arrive between December 8th and 10th.

C: PAC Treasurer – Sherrylynn

Money coming in over the last month with, Coupon Books and Neufields. Had an issue with Sin A Men Bun Co. not depositing their cheque. Main Chequing Account is currently siting at \$18,387 and Gaming Account is currently sitting at \$10,497.

D: Hot Lunch – Sara

Things are going well. We're currently doing 1 Hot Lunch Day a month. Sara is always looking for Volunteers to come help out with sorting and delivering. Approximately 150 Kids order Hot Lunch each time, and there are approximately 400 Students in LME.

E: Popcorn

Popcorn is going good. Kids are enjoying it. There will only be 1 Popcorn Day in December, due to other activities happening throughout the month. And will resume on January 7th when we come back from the break. Tyrra has put the receipt for supplies in the Office. Our cost is currently around 0.15/Bag, which gives us a 0.85/Bag profit on Popcorn Sales. Golden Egg Days are the last Wednesday of each month, with one prize going to 1 Primary Student and one prize going to 1 Intermediate Student.

F: Playground Sub Committee – Nina

Nina has received some price points and some layouts for possible playground equipment. Haven't received exact measurements of the playground, which is necessary to apply for some of the grants that are coming up in January, such as resurfacing the playground. ~~Meeting on November 27th to get more details.~~ Meeting with Habitat on November 27th, was canceled. What do we feel is the most important equipment to help make our playground more accessible?

G: PAC DPAC – Kayla

Discussion of different ways to advertise things going on in our school such as Fundraisers or needing Parent Volunteers such as a Whiteboard on Wheels or Sandwich Board. Sending out PAC specific Emails to parents if they would like to receive them. Some new ideas for Hot Lunch Days done in school, such as Walking Tacos, which has a higher profit margin, sold at \$4.50/Bag. Food Safe Certification for PAC Members something to look into. Kayla also looked into how our Breakfast Program is going in LME. Program was waiting for new refrigeration to arrive.
